Composers

Order of the Musical Periods: **Baroque, Classical, Romantic and Modern**

Baroque Period: JS Bach; The English established the 13 colonies in North America during this period.

Classical Period: Beethoven; George Washington was US President during this period.

Romantic Period: Abraham Lincoln was President during this period.

Modern Period: Music of the USA included Ragtime, Blues, Jazz, Country and Popular/ Rock.

Listening: Minuet in G Major, BWV Anh 114 from AM Bach Notebook: Ode to Joy Theme by Beethoven

Theory

The music alphabet: forward, backward; stepping up & down, skipping up & down

Name the keys on a piano

Bass Clef = F Clef, Treble Clef = G clef

Note values in 3/4 and 4/4

Whole, half, dotted half, half and quarter notes

Quarter rest

interval of 2nd, 3rd and 5th, melodic & harmonic

Pentascals & Major Chords, root position, for: C, F and G.

Staff & Notation

Bass C3 to Treble C5, recognize notes and name the lines and spaces

Treble clef, bass clef, p, f, rit., ritard., ritardando

Flat, Sharp and Natural signs and placement on the staff

3/4, 4/4 and Common Time Signatures, measure, Bass & Treble Clefs

stem direction of notes

Double bar and repeat sign.

Staccato notes, slurred notes

Instruments

Four families of instruments: Strings, Woodwinds, Brass & Percussion

Recognize pictures of the: **string family**, Violin; **percussion family**, Triangle, Cymbals, Drum;
woodwind family, Flute; **brass family**, Tuba; and a conductor's baton.
