Composers/Musical Periods

Order of the Musical Periods: Baroque, Classical, Romantic and Modern

Baroque Period: The English established the 13 colonies in North America during this period.

Classical Period: George Washington was US President during this period. **Romantic Period**: Abraham Lincoln was President during this period.

Modern Period: Music of the USA included Blues, Soul, Jazz, Country and Popular/ Rock.

Theory

The music alphabet: forward, backward; stepping up & down, skipping up & down

Bass Clef = F Clef, Treble Clef = G clef

Note values in 3/4 and 4/4

Whole, half, dotted half, half and quarter notes interval of 2nd, 3rd and 5th, melodic & harmonic

Pentascales & Major Chords for: C, F and G.

Staff & Notation

Bass C3 to Treble C5, recognize notes and name the lines and spaces Flat, Sharp and Natural signs 3/4, 4/4 and Common Time Signatures, measure, Bass & Treble Clefs stem direction of notes
Double bar and repeat sign.
Staccato notes, slurred notes

Instruments

Four families of instruments: Strings, Woodwinds, Brass & Percussion Recognize pictures of: **string family**, Violin; **percussion family**, Triangle, Cymbals, Drum; **woodwind family**, Flute; **brass family**, Tuba; and a conductor's baton

Vocabulary

Pentascale/scale triad ritardando, rit. legato, staccato p, piano, f, forte repeat sign sharp sign, flat sign
